01 WHY THIS WORKSHOP?

For relevant products, EU customers may request origin, traceability and legality information from suppliers. Help your team understand what to collect, how to review it and where follow-up is needed.

Check relevance

Understand product scope and your role in the supply chain.

Organise evidence

Connect suppliers, origin information and supporting records.

03

Plan next steps

Identify information gaps and prioritise follow-up actions.

02 WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Procurement and sourcing teams; supply chain managers; exporters and traders; sustainability, compliance and supplier-development personnel.

Especially businesses handling relevant products from wood, rubber, oil palm, coffee, cocoa, soy or cattle supply chains. Product coverage depends on the applicable scope.

MORNING / FOUNDATIONS

1 Scope & supply-chain roles

Relevant commodities and products; distinguish EU operator responsibilities from non-EU supplier information needs.

2 Origin & traceability

Supplier mapping, production locations and geolocation information; link product records through the supply chain.

3 Evidence requirements

Understand deforestation-free and legality evidence, information quality and common documentation gaps.

AFTERNOON / APPLICATION

4 Due diligence & risk

Explore the due diligence process, risk assessment and mitigation concepts using a supply-chain example.

5 Supplier evidence review

Use a checklist to review a sample supplier pack; identify missing, inconsistent or unsupported information.

6 Readiness action plan

Prioritise requests to suppliers, assign internal responsibilities and prepare a practical follow-up plan.

03 WHAT YOU TAKE AWAY

Training materials; a supplier information checklist; a practical evidence-review exercise; a readiness action-plan template; and a certificate of participation.

Bring a laptop and a basic understanding of your products and suppliers. Case exercises use sample information; confidential supplier data is not required.
